Royal Far West visit

We will be welcoming back clinicians, Tayla, Lily and Darby, from Royal Far West on **Monday 6th May – Thursday 9th May**, delivering a range of supports as part of their Community Recovery service. The visit will include:

Stormbirds Reconnector:

As part of the Stormbirds Reconnector session, children will revisit concepts from the program such as:

- Learn change is part of life and prepare for change
- Name and care for feelings
- Develop skills for coping, problem solving and decision making
- Build their support network with families, friends, teachers and others

If your child participated in the Stormbirds group during our previous visit, they will be included in the session. Please get in touch with school staff if you have any questions or concerns.

Parent/carer drop-in sessions:

Do you have a question you would like to ask a RFW clinician? Common questions we get asked by parents:

- My child goes from 0-100, what can I do?
- My kids just don't seem to get along, how do I manage sibling conflict?
- We have gone through a lot of changes and stressful events in the last year, how do I help prepare the kids for this?

Maybe you just want to know what an Occupational Therapist, Speech Pathologist, Social Worker, or Clinical Psychologist can do to help you or your child.

Please speak to Rebecca in the office if you are interested in meeting/speaking with an RFW clinician – this could be in person or over the phone. Please let her know all your available days, if you are available in the morning, afternoon or all day, and your preference of in-person or phone.

Educator support:

As part of professional learning for teaching staff, clinicians will be spending time in each class to gain an understanding of how the classroom runs and provide suggestions to teachers on supporting learners in the classroom. If you have concerns or questions about your child being present for these classroom visits and do not want your child involved, **please notify the classroom teacher or school staff before Monday 6th May 2024**.


