

Kindergarten Orientation - Session Two

Our next Kinder Orientation Session will be held on Monday 11 November and will be a full school day. This week students will also have the opportunity to meet our Year 5 (Year 6, 2025) buddies and complete lots of fun activities with them.

School Swimming Scheme

The Department of Education K-6 Swimming Scheme is a program to teach children the very important skills involved in water safety. This includes developing water confidence and providing students with basic skills in water safety and survival.

This year the School Swim Scheme sessions will be conducted over 5 days, consisting of 2 x 60minute lessons. We will be walking to the Evans Head Aquatic Centre from school daily at 11:20am and returning by 2:30pm. There will be no staff remaining at school on these days.

This program has been subsidised by the NSW School Sport Unit Grant, making this a FREE program for all students.


Presentation Evening
