School Swimming Scheme



The Department of Education K-6 Swimming Scheme is a program to teach children the very important skills involved in water safety. This includes developing water confidence and providing students with basic skills in water safety and survival.

This year the School Swim Scheme sessions will be conducted over 5 days, consisting of 2 x 60-minute lessons. We will be walking to the Evans Head Aquatic Centre from school daily at 11:20am and returning by 2:30pm. There will be no staff remaining at school on these days.

This program has been subsidised by the NSW School Sport Unit Grant, making this a FREE program for all students.
